Setting aside a few minutes each day during Advent to 'light' the candle(s) and worship will help everyone to get ready for Jesus' birthday celebration! On the fourth Sunday before Christmas Day burn the first candle, read the Scripture references, sing a carol and pray. On the next Sunday, you will burn the first and second candle. Continue in this manner until the Sunday before Christmas when you will burn all four candles.

On Christmas Day you burn the 'Christ Candle', signifying that Jesus has come!
